

VACATIONING AT THE SCOTTSDALE CAMELBACK

Scottsdale is situated in the heart of Arizona's Sonoran Desert. DIRECTIONS

From Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport
(approximately 20mins to resort):
Take 44th Street north to Camelback Road. And then turn right on Camelback Road. The resort is situated on the left just before 64th Street.

From the rental car facility:

(approximately 30mins to resort):
You will come out on Sky Harbor Circle to Buckeye St. and turn right (east), proceed to 24th St. and turn left (north). Take 24th to Camelback Rd. and turn right (east), stay on Camelback Rd. for approx. 5.5miles to the resort.

TRANSPORTATION

BY CAR: Most people choose cars as the most convenient and economical way to get around. Please note that if you are renting a car from the airport you will be subject to a rather substantial airport tax. The onsite concierge offers competitive rates; therefore, you may want to consider contacting them prior to arrival. Complimentary area maps are available at the resort.

BY BUS: Arizona offers an affordable bus service. Always remember to have exact change ready when taking local buses. Fares are approximately \$1.25 with free transfers- special rates are available for seniors and small children. Rates may change; therefore, check with the property upon arrival.

Driving Hazards

Summer heat in the low desert puts an extra strain on both cars and drivers. Make sure your cooling system, engine oil, transmission fluid, fan belt and tires are in top condition. Always carry several gallons of water in case of a breakdown or radiator trouble.

At times the desert has too much water. Late-summer storm floods create low spots in the road. If you encounter this road hazard, wait for the water to go down before you cross. Dust storms also tend to be short-lived and they can completely block visibility. The best thing to do in a dust storm is to pull completely off the road, stop and turn off your lights so as not to confuse other drivers.

WHEN TO GO

The first thing you should know is that the desert can be cold as well as hot. The winter months in Phoenix and Tucson can receive nightly temperatures below freezing and the days can be too cold for sunning or swimming. Generally, winters in Arizona are positively delightful. The all-around best times to visit are in spring and autumn, when temperatures are cool in the mountains and warm in the desert but without extremes.

THE UNITS AT THE SCOTTSDALE CAMELBACK

All units are non smoking and no pets are allowed! Both of these policies are strictly enforced and guests will be charged for not complying.

The **One Bedroom unit** can accommodate a maximum of 4 people with one queen bed in the upstairs loft and one king bed in the sleeping area (separated from the living area by a privacy curtain). Each unit features air-conditioning, a fireplace in the living area, a small balcony, a kitchenette (microwave, stove top, full fridge, dishwasher but no conventional oven) and washer and dryer. There is one bathroom.

The **Two Bedroom unit** can accommodate a maximum of 6 people with one king bed in the master, two twin beds in the second bedroom, and a sofa bed in the living area. Each unit is very spacious and features air-conditioning, a full kitchen, a fireplace in the living room, and a terrace or patio. There are two bathrooms.

The **Three Bedroom unit** can accommodate a maximum of 8 people with one king bed in the master, one queen bed in the second bedroom, two twins in the third bedroom, and a sofa bed in the living area. Each unit is very spacious and features air-conditioning, a full kitchen, a fireplace in the living room, and a terrace or patio. There are two bathrooms.

Housekeeping Service

Your unit is cleaned once during your stay. For example, if you arrive on Saturday your unit will be cleaned on Tuesday and if you arrive on Sunday your unit will be cleaned on Wednesday.

SPECIAL NOTE

Please remember that you are NOT obligated to attend any timeshare presentation. If you do attend and decide to purchase another vacation plan with your current Membership as a trade in please keep in mind that any transfer form you may sign is NOT a legitimate transfer. Please refer to your Membership Plan "Transfer of Membership". Often these companies do NOT complete the transfer and you will own two plans. Furthermore the rules state the transfer must be to another individual and must be approved and signed by the Club Manager. Until that process is completed a transfer is not deemed a legitimate transfer and you are still responsible for your Membership Fees (loan must be paid in full). If upgrading is of interest, call your Club when you get home.
